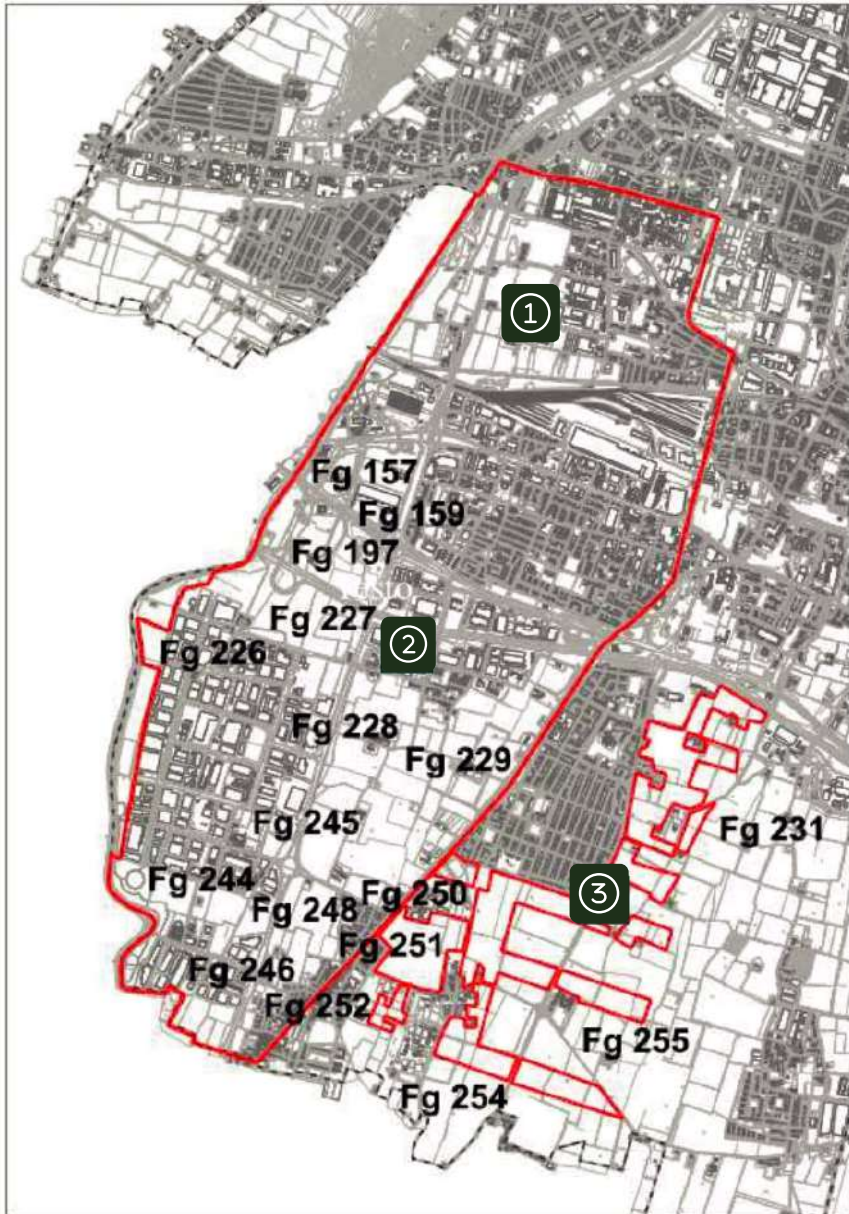
Prohibitions and restrictions of ordinance n.208:

What you need to know

The mayoral ordinance N.208 of 11/20/2024 (issued at the request of ATS which defines its main contents) imposes important restrictions in the south-western area of Brescia and in the site of national interest "Brescia-Caffaro" from January 1 to December 31, 2025.

These measures are fundamental to protect public health.

Perimetro Ordinanza

Areas affected by restrictions



Area between Milano street to the north, the Milano-Venice railway to the south, the Mella river to the west and Industriale, Tempini and Dalmazia streets to the east



Zone south of the Milano-Venice railway

From the railway boundary to the southern municipal limit, between the Mella river and Dalmazia, Corsica, Labirinto and Fornaci streets.



Specific agricultural areas

Areas to the east and south of Villaggio Sereno.

1. Food Activities

What can I grow in my garden?

It is permitted to cultivate in private gardens, for family management and personal consumption, some specific vegetables:



Fruit vegetables

Tomato, eggplant, cucumber



Root vegetables

Onion, garlic, fennel



Leafy vegetables

Cabbage, cauliflower



Legumes

Bean, pea



1. Food Activities

What if I want to grow other vegetables?

You can do it.

However, you must necessarily
follow some rules



Use only deep boxes



Fill the boxes only with
uncontaminated soil



Use tools dedicated only to these
cultivations



What rules must I follow for all crops?



You must always wear gloves and boots

To avoid direct contact with the soil.



You must always wash thoroughly the products

Remove all traces of soil before consuming them.



Dispose of all vegetable waste material

Following the same disposal methods for cuttings provided by the ordinance.
